

# Coffey Creek, Clarus ink new deals

Three new tenants have signed leases at Coffey Creek Business Park, an office and warehouse development just off of Beam Road.

Metrolina Trauma Advisory Committee recently signed a lease for 15,000 square feet at 1110 Center Park Drive, where it will have offices and warehouse space. MTAC is one of eight regional advisory councils established in 1998 for the development of trauma and disaster preparedness.

CMC-Home Infusion & Equipment, a division of Carolinas Medical Center that administers infusion and oxygen services for patients in their homes, has also leased 6,000 square feet in the same 30,000-square-foot building for five years. And Argix Direct Inc., a logistics company that helps retailers move merchandise from source to store, has leased 20,256 square feet at the 61,000-square-foot 1805 Center Park Drive building for three years.
